Application window to write or renew by exam > **June 1 – September 1**
Exam window > **November 1 – 15**

Application window to renew by CL > **January 14 – November 1**
Apply by June 1 to save 10% on your renewal fee

Note: Once CNA certified, your CHPCN(C) credential is valid for a five-year term.
